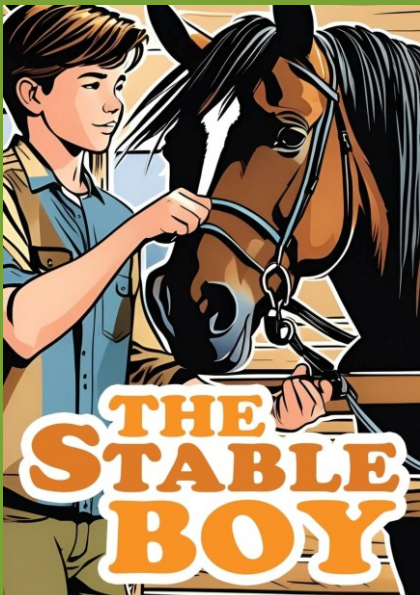

In the last year over 400 people have come to a profess Jesus as their Lord and savior because of the work of Said and his family. The Issachar Imperative organization helps equip people of faith with a Biblical Worldview. This is done through monthly meetings, the yearly Worldview Institute, and through other educational events and articles.

The goal is "to understand the prevailing world views that exist in our culture by analyzing headline events on a weekly basis and discussing their implications. We ask what world view is behind the actions of each event and what would be the appropriate Biblical World View of the same event? And then we ask ourselves, "What should we do?" It's simple, but stretching, enlightening, and motivating."

Property Updates

The church property is large – between 15 and 20 acres. That means it takes constant upkeep and work to ensure it remains capable of meeting the needs of the ministry. Here are some recent updates regarding the property:

- We are looking forward to our service day in April (Saturday, April 5th). Typically, these days involve working around and on the church property. Things like seeding grass, pulling weeds, mulching playgrounds and flower beds, machinery maintenance, cleaning the building, purging unneeded items, cleaning carpets, and the like are the types of tasks needed on that day. So, if you can help, it would be greatly appreciated.
- Our library needs updating to meet the needs of the people using the room. Since the room is not used as a library anymore and is instead used for meetings, classes, and Bible studies, the idea is to update it to fit those needs. The room will then be worked

on to provide more seating and table space, technology resources and tools, and other things needed for that kind of space.

- Our baptistry fountain will be reopened as soon as the weather permits (which means the temperature stays above freezing overnight). Last year one of our Connect Groups graciously donated the money to purchase some benches to place near the baptistry. The idea is, people can sit by the waterfall and enjoy the sound of the water, pray, talk, and otherwise enjoy the area. These benches will likely be purchased soon and placed when the weather warms up.



- We need more space for the youth and other activities that currently take place in the school, on the lower level, and in the fellowship hall. Please pray for God to open a door of provision for this need.
- We are in the process of obtaining quotes to repair the driveway entrances near the main road. We are looking to have those done as soon as possible, weather dependent.

MUSIC MOMENTS "Goodness of God"

Oh, that men would give thanks to the Lord for His goodness, and for His wonderful works to the children of men! For He satisfies the longing soul, and fills the hungry soul with goodness." – Psalm 107:8-9

Have you ever thought about what it means when we say God is good? There are numerous verses in the Bible that mention the goodness of God. Many of the songs that we sing in corporate worship remind us of the goodness of God. The word "good" itself can mean different things depending on how it is used. As an adjective it can mean "to be desired or approved of." As a noun it can mean "what is morally right, or righteous." And certainly God is all these things, but I think more importantly, it is just as true to say, "God is good simply because He is God."

So when we sing a song that says "Your goodness is running after, it's running after me" – we're reminding ourselves that God Himself is by our side, running after us, sustaining us in our ministry. When we come to Him and surrender our lives to His will, He will never leave our side, even through the most difficult trials and storms. "All my life You have been faithful. All my life You have been so, so good." Let us never stop singing about the goodness of God.



Spiritual Care: Out of the Darkness & Into the Light

John 8:12. As we shake off the cold of winter and welcome the warmth of the spring sun, many of us may notice a shift in our mood. The sadness and spiritual darkness often felt most strongly during the winter season begin to fade away. Did you know that sunlight offers numerous mental health and physical benefits? Sunlight increases serotonin production in the brain, a neurotransmitter linked to feelings of happiness and well-being. Spending time in the sun also benefits our bones, skin, muscle strength, and more. It's no wonder the Lord gave us the sun!

In John 8:12, Jesus declares, "I am the light of the world." Just as the sun has healing properties for our physical bodies, Jesus offers healing for both our spirit and flesh. When we spend time in God's Word, reflecting on His truths, we allow the Holy Spirit to minister to our souls, bringing about profound healing. As we do so, the spiritual darkness will be overcome, and depression may

begin to dissipate as the light of Jesus shines down on us, within us, and through His Word.

One simple practice we can incorporate into our daily lives for better mental health is to spend more time in the sun. This spring, consider setting aside time for your daily devotion outdoors on warm, sunny days. Let the light of the sun and the light of the world (Jesus) uplift your spirit and bring you renewed hope and joy.

Preschool - Kindergarten Sunday School: Series Jelly Beans (Meets upstairs in PreK Classroom)

The children are starting a new Sunday School Series, "Jelly Beans", the SWEET Story of Easter. The colors of the jelly beans will help them to remember 4 important parts of the Easter Story. They will be learning the following Scriptures this month:

- White Jelly Bean: John 13:1-, Jesus washes the disciples' feet.
- Red Jelly Bean: Matthew 16:21-23, John 18:1-14, Jesus is arrested and the disciples scatter.
- Black Jelly Beans: Matthew 16:1-5, John 19:17-30, Luke 23:39-43 Jesus dies and is buried.
- Yellow Jelly Bean: John 20:1-18, Jesus Rises from the tomb.

1st - 4th Grade Sunday School: "Opposite Day". Radical Wisdom from The Sermon on the Mount. (Downstairs Classroom)

The kids are still in the series, "Opposite Day". Radical Wisdom from The Sermon on the Mount. This series gives us a picture of how Jesus wants us to live, love and treat other people, which was radically different from the wisdom of his day...and today. Sometimes God's way is opposite of our way.

- Talking to God: Matthew 6:5-15, I can always talk to God.
- Worry Scmorry: Matthew 6:25-34, I don't have to worry because God knows what I need.
- Don't Judge Me: Matthew 7:1-6, "With God" I will show grace to others because God has shown grace to me.
- Tight Fit: Matthew 7:13-14, "With God", I can follow His ways, even when it is hard.

Sunday School 5th and 6th Grade: (Downstairs Classroom)

Luke 15:11-32 Revealing God as our Father

The kids are doing an in-depth study, line by line, of the lessons learned in "The Parable of the Prodigal Son".

Wednesday Evening Ministry - 6:30-8:30: H2O Kids - Drop off at the Fellowship Hall

Please sign your children in at the Fellowship Hall. All the children start the evening together with games, a skit and worship. The age groups split up, K-2nd grades/3rd-5th grades for the Lesson, small group discussion and craft.

The children are starting a new Bible Series, "Gone Fishing", Committed to Jesus, Hook, Line and Sinker. A fishing-themed series looking at the ministry of Jesus.

- Make Waves: Matthew 14:22-23, Jesus walks on water, kids will learn that in good and bad, we should keep our eyes on Jesus.
- All Hands on Deck: Luke 10:1-12, 17-20, Jesus sends out the Seventy Two, Kids will learn that Jesus can use us to share the good news.

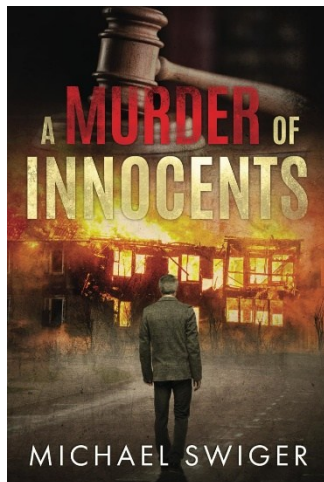

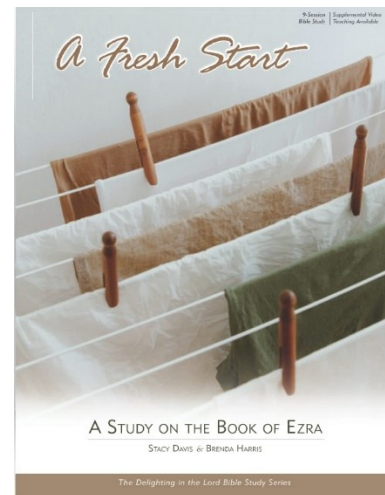
