

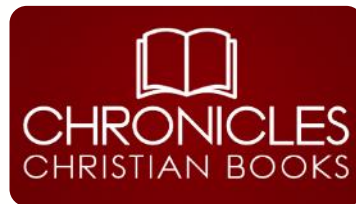

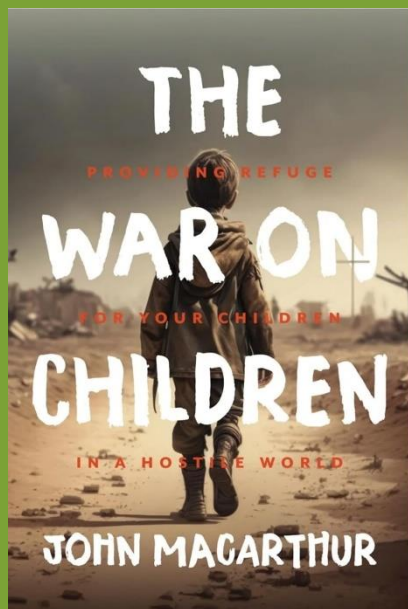

Monthly Updates

An Update from the Pastor...



Hi everyone! Welcome to 2025! It is my prayer for you that, this year, you will be blessed above and beyond last year, and that you will experience God move in mighty ways in your life. I have to say, I am excited for the new opportunities God will provide us as a congregation

2024 was certainly a blessed year, though, and we saw incredible growth and ministry happen. After looking through the records and numbers from last year, it is clear God was moving in and through this church. We baptized several dozen people last year – something that is always exciting! Vacation Bible School saw the most kids ever. We added the coffee bar in the main lobby, which has been a great blessing to many, and has led to

new opportunities for people to serve. The bookstore sold 750 books, and because we price things as low as we do, we calculate that people saved more than \$4,000 shopping there instead of elsewhere. Our shoebox project with Samaritan's Purse saw more shoeboxes filled and sent out from here than ever; in all, just under 1100 boxes left the building to go to kids around the world. We held our weekly family meals where we served between 700 and 800 people

throughout the season. We sent out mission teams and performed service projects. We said goodbye to some loved ones in 2024 and welcomed new friends. We faced challenges and overcame obstacles. We saw the church grow and thrive in numbers and maturity, and it is clear that God was with us throughout 2024.

All that to say, I cannot wait to see what God does in 2025! But whatever it may be, "I am sure of this, that He who began a good work in you will bring it to completion" (Phil 1:6). God bless, everyone!

Property Updates

The church property is large – between 15 and 20 acres. That means it takes constant upkeep and work to ensure it remains capable of meeting the needs of the ministry. Here are some recent updates regarding the property:

- At the start of this month Lee Rufe joined our staff as a part-time maintenance coordinator. Lee will help us keep the building and the grounds in good working order. Please join us in welcoming Lee to our team.
- We are well into the winter months and continue to praise the Lord for the beauty that winter weather brings. With that, we do ask that you bear with us as our heating system works non-stop to keep the building comfortable. We realize that certain rooms may be slightly cooler than others and may require a sweater or jacket. Being proactive in these measures can help us keep heating costs down during the extreme cold.
- We need more space for the youth and other activities that currently take



place in the school, on the lower level, and in the fellowship hall. Please pray for God to open a door of provision for this need.

- The driveway entrances near the main road need to be repaired. This has been discussed and we are looking to have those done as soon as possible, weather dependent.



- Our library needs updating to meet the needs of the people using the room. Since the room is not used as a library anymore and is instead used for meetings, classes, and Bible studies, the idea is to update it to fit those needs. The plan is to keep books needed by the church and have a book fair at some point to allow people from the church a chance to purchase books from the library collection, with the rest being donated. The room will then be worked on to provide more seating and table space, technology resources and tools, and other things needed for that kind of space.

Thank you all for your continued help and support! Please pray for our volunteers who help with the property and please consider serving in this area if you are able!

MUSIC MOMENTS "Trading My Sorrows"

Sing praises to the Lord, O you his saints, and give thanks to his holy name. For his anger is but for a moment, and his favor is for a lifetime. Weeping may tarry for the night, but joy comes with the morning." – Psalm 30:4-5

One of my favorite songs to lead in worship is "Trading My Sorrows" by Darrell Evans. It's a classic modern worship song from the late 90's that is just as relevant to the believer today as it was when it was published. Spiritual Care: New Year, New Hope

Join us on Saturday February 1st to help make chocolate candies as part of our H2O Valentines Day fundraiser! All proceeds go towards the H2O mission trip.

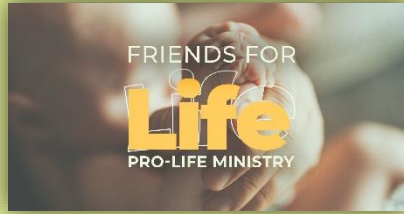
GET INVOLVED AT SHEPHERD OF THE HILLS
