

Heroes International is a collaborative charity bringing life-changing relief to orphans, widows, and the disadvantaged.

Currently providing help to Ukrainian refugees:

- Staff work to transport refugees (particularly widows and orphans) impacted by war and civil unrest to safe spaces
- Staff are often driving hundreds of miles daily to deliver aid like medicine, food, bottled water and other essentials to people in shelters.

Mulch was added to the playground. In total, about 40 cubic yards of mulch was added and it looks great! Thank you to all who helped.

We held our annual spring-cleaning day and many people came out to help, and the building and property look fantastic.

Please continue to pray for a building to meet the increasing needs of the youth and school-aged ministries within the church.

We are planning to add benches near the water fountain out front. A small group generously donated money for that project last year and with the weather warming up, it will be nice to be able to sit next to the waterfall. So be on the lookout for that. The library renovation is in full swing with the room being turned into a conference room better suited for meetings, classes, and Bible studies. The books and shelves are gone, and we have had several people sign up to help with drywall. "Through Christ in Me"

"I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me." – Galatians 2:20

"To this I hold my hope is only Jesus, all the glory evermore to Him. When the race is complete still my lips shall repeat yet not I but through Christ in me."

I love singing songs that are full of meaning and theology. Don't get me wrong I think there's also great value in singing a chorus or a song that only has one central theme. But songs like "Yet Not I but Through Christ in Me" pack a wealth of theological concepts, Biblical truths and statements that are core to our faith and a great reminder of what we believe.

This fairly new worship song written in early 2018 is a worship song I consider a great creed of our faith and underscores our need for our Savior Jesus Christ. It is a powerful reminder of what He has done for us through His death and resurrection, but also serves as a great reminder of our need for Him each day.

Spiritual Care:

The Veil Was Torn

Mathew 27:51. Prior to Christ's death, the temple veil blocked access to the Holiest of Holies, where God's presence resided. Only the high priest could enter annually to make atonement for sins, leaving others separated from God. Through Christ's sacrifice for our sins, the veil was torn, allowing all believers direct entry to God's presence. As Christians, we are sealed by the Holy Spirit, liberated to enjoy a close relationship with Him. However, mental health challenges can spark unwanted intrusive thoughts and impulsive actions, leading us to question our salvation.

Be confident: Christ's sacrifice redeems us, and the Spirit anchors us. We can approach God boldly, fully assured of our salvation, regardless of our struggles.

This assurance empowers us to navigate life's trials with hope. While mental health struggles may persist, they do not define our standing before God. The torn veil signifies that no barrier, neither sin nor suffering, can separate us from His love. By relying on the Holy Spirit, we find strength to confront our challenges and grow in faith. We are invited to bring our burdens to God in prayer, trusting that His grace is sufficient. As we rest in Christ's finished work, we can live with courage, knowing our salvation is secure and our relationship with God is eternal.

Sunday Morning Kids Ministries:

8:00 AM Service: Kids are dismissed following the Good News Mystery Box to the Children's Room for a Bible lesson followed by fellowship and play.

9:30 AM Service: Kids are encouraged to attend our Sunday School for all ages for the whole 9:30-10:30 AM hour. We also have childcare for infants and toddlers.

11:00 AM Service: Kids are dismissed following the Good News Mystery Box to Children's Church and Care Room

Preschool - Kindergarten Sunday School: Adventures of Moses (Meets upstairs in PreK Classroom)

The children are starting a new Sunday School Series," Adventures of Moses" They will be learning the following Scriptures this month.

- A Special Baby: Exodus 2:1-10, Kids will learn, "God can help me no matter what"
- The Burning Bush: Exodus 3:1-12, Kids will learn, "God shows me what is right, even if I don't know"
- Let my People Go: Exodus 7:8-2, Kids will learn," God helps me do things that are hard, even when I don't think I can"
- God Parts the Sea: Exodus 14:9-29, Kids will learn, "I can trust God no matter what"

1st - 4th Grade Sunday School: (Downstairs Classroom)

The kids have just finished the series, "Opposite Day", Radical Wisdom from The Sermon on the Mount. We have started to teach a new series titled, "Psalms, The Big Book of Big Emotions". We taught the first lesson at the end of April, starting with Anxiety, Psalm 1, turning to God when I feel anxious. Parents, please see the "Make it Stick" papers we send home with the children, for a better description and how to reenforce what they are learning throughout the week.

- Sadness: Psalm 6: Kids will learn, "I can talk to God when I'm sad and He will comfort me"
- Confidence: Psalm 19: Kids will learn, I can be confident because of God's power, not my own."
- Peace: Psalm 23: Kids will learn, God gives us peace even in hard times"
- Loneliness: Psalm 25: Kids will learn, "God is there when I feel alone

Sunday School 5th and 6th Grade: (Downstairs Classroom)

The kids will be finishing the study on "The Prodigal Son" They will then begin a journey through "The Sermon on the Mount, starting with a discussion on The Way, The Truth and The Life.

Wednesday Evening Ministry - 6:30-8:30: H2O Kids - Drop off at the Fellowship Hall

Please sign your children in at the Fellowship Hall. All the children start the evening together with games, a skit and worship. The age groups split up, K-2nd grades/3rd-5th grades for the Lesson, small group discussion and craft.

The children are starting a new Bible Series, "Gone Fishing", Committed to Jesus, Hook, Line and Sinker. A fishing-themed series looking at the ministry of Jesus.

Scripture inspiration: Mark 1:17, "Come and follow me and I will make you fishers of men"

- On the Hook: Luke 10-38-42, Mary an Martha
 - The children will learn that spending time with Jesus might mean saying no to other things.
- Not Just A Fish Story: Mark 9:14-29, Jesus Heals a Boy
 - The kids will learn that Jesus can take away my doubts.
- Cast Out Your Line: Matthew 17:24-27, Coin from a Fish
 - Children will learn God will meet all of my needs, sometimes in unexpected ways.
- A Fish Out of Water: Bartimaeus Receives His Sight
 - Kids will learn if I seek after Jesus, He will change my life for the better.

Have your children bring a friend or neighbor to Youth club so they too can hear about Jesus and have fun while learning. Please pray for the teachers, helpers and the children, asking that we all be led by the Holy Spirit as we dig into God's amazing Word.


