

Derrick Whitmore is the founder and currently serves as the Executive Director of Shattered Studios, a non-profit organization that shares hope and faith through the creative, performance, and media arts.

While serving as the youth pastor of Shepherd of the Hills, Derrick observed some of the youth were dealing with similar levels of depression and even suicidal thoughts. He felt the urgent need to gather a team together to specifically address this need and soon Shattered Studios was formed. Not long after, Derrick felt God calling to devote more time into working with those struggling with depression and, as a result, he began working for Shattered Studios full time. Due to the



The church property is large – between 15 and 20 acres. That means it takes constant upkeep and work to ensure it remains capable of meeting the needs of the ministry. Here are some recent updates regarding the property:

Please continue to pray for a building to meet the increasing needs of the youth and school-aged ministries within the church.

We are planning to add benches near the water fountain out front. A small group generously donated money for that project last year and with the weather warming up, it will be nice to be able to sit next to the waterfall. So be on the lookout for that.

The library renovation is in full swing with the room being turned into a conference room better suited for meetings, classes, and Bible studies. The books and shelves are gone, and drywall is in the final stages of installation. We will still need help finishing the walls, including sanding and painting. If you would like to help

with this project, please let us know by filling out a yellow card in the sanctuary seats.

Our school (Calvary Christian Academy) is expanding this Fall, and we will be preparing the classrooms downstairs to accommodate the increased enrollment. A family in the church has generously donated funds to divide room 22/23 into two full separate classrooms, with room 22 becoming a science lab.

Our mowing team is doing a great job with maintaining the property. If you are interested in helping with mowing or other ground maintenance (like pulling weeds, trimming, leaf collection in the fall, etc.), please let us know by filling out a yellow card.



Later this summer we are looking into expanding our bookstore with additional shelving and inventory graciously obtained from another local bookstore that has since gone out of business. The new shelving will expand our inventory and allow us to provide even more resources to help you grow in your faith.

"Through Christ in Me"

"I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me." – Galatians 2:20

"To this I hold my hope is only Jesus, all the glory evermore to Him. When the race is complete still my lips shall repeat yet not I but through Christ in me."

I love singing songs that are full of meaning and theology. Don't get me wrong I think there's also great value in singing a chorus or a song that only has one central theme. But songs like "Yet Not I but Through Christ in Me" pack a wealth of theological concepts, Biblical truths and statements that are core to our faith and a great reminder of what we believe.

This fairly new worship song written in early 2018 is a worship song I consider a great creed of our faith and underscores our need for our Savior Jesus Christ. It is a powerful reminder of what He has done for us through His death and resurrection but also serves as a great reminder of our need for Him each day.

Spiritual Care:

Deep Calls to Deep

"Deep calls to deep in the roar of your waterfalls; all your waves and breakers have swept over me." (Psalm 42:7, NIV)

This verse paints a vivid picture of overwhelming emotions, like waves crashing over the soul. The psalmist is in a place of deep longing, perhaps even despair, crying out for God amidst turmoil. Yet, in this raw honesty, there's a profound truth: God meets us in the depths of our emotions. The "deep" of our pain, fear, or yearning is not a place God avoids, it's where His deep love calls to us.

When life's breakers sweep over us, it's tempting to feel abandoned. But this verse reminds me that God uses these very depths to draw us closer to Him. Our raw emotions of grief, doubt, or even desperation become the meeting ground where His Spirit speaks, offering comfort and hope. In the roar of life's waterfalls, His love is louder, inviting us to trust Him more deeply.

Today, we are reminded that no emotion is too heavy for God. He doesn't just tolerate our struggles; He uses them to pull us into the depths of His unending love, where we find peace that surpasses understanding.

Do you feel overwhelmed with deep emotions today? Take five minutes to reflect on this scripture and be reminded that as deep as your pain may be, God's love is all the deeper.

Preschool - Kindergarten Sunday School: Adventures of Moses (Meets upstairs in PreK Classroom)

The children are starting a new Sunday School Series," Toy Bible Stories" Toys can teach us about serving God! Toy boxes are filled with all different kinds of toys, for different reasons, but they are all used for one main purpose; to play. All through the Bible God used very different people to carry out His main purpose; to let the world know who God is and how much He loves us.

The kids are continuing in the series titled, "Psalms, The Big Book of Big Emotions". We will introduce our 2nd Memory Verse for this series: "Lord who rules over all, blessed is the person who trusts in you." Parents, please see the "Make it Stick" papers we send home with the children, for a better description and how to reinforce what they are learning throughout the week.


