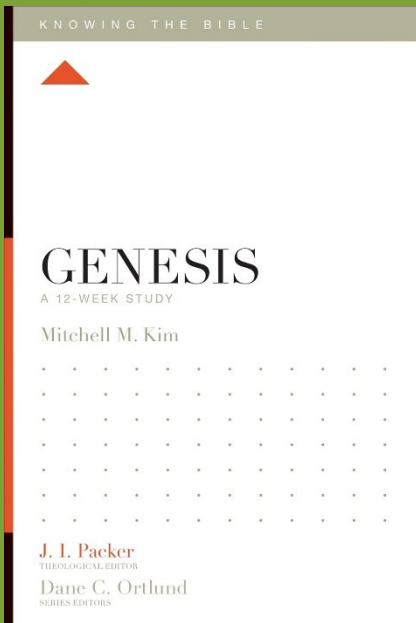

Are you interested in serving here at Shepherd of the Hills? Here are just a few areas that have an active need.

WE'RE HIRING! A Part-time (Salaried, 32 hours) Ministry Assistant. Mon-Thurs: 9:00 am – 4:00 pm; Friday: 9:00 am – 1:00 pm.

This position consists of primarily office work, conducted at a desk. While some tasks will require walking, standing, crouching, and lifting (<25 lbs.), most work will be done from a seated position. The Ministry Assistant shall be responsible for the overall management and administration of the church office. S/He will also serve in a simultaneous capacity as the Sr. Pastor's administrative assistant. Due to the nature of the ministry, this position requires a high degree of confidentiality and as such the person selected must be trustworthy and honest. August Missions

After his conversion to Christianity in 1971 Bob became affiliated with Jews for Jesus in 1979. He is the leader of Jews for Jesus Austral/Asia, a territory which now includes Singapore and New Zealand as well. He lives in Sydney with his wife.

Bob travels throughout the world sharing the message of Messiah Y'shua. He has preached or ministered on the streets in Korea, New Zealand, Singapore, Argentina, visited 47 of the 50 states in the US, all over the traps in Australia from Perth to Townsville to Melbourne to Port Macquarie. Not only is Bob's style winsome, but his message of faith in Jesus is powerful.

Bob is also the creator and director of Project Timothy, an international messianic internship and discipleship program for young adults from 18-25.

Bob Mendelsohn is our **Missions Commitment** focus for the month of August. Bob currently serves in Sydney, Australia with Jews for Jesus.

"I had always been proud to be Jewish. There was some mystique to all these dos and don'ts that were supposed to improve me as a person and, in particular, as a Jew. I was fervent, not so much about God, but about "doing" Judaism correctly. It was my job, as a Jew, to observe these commands and comply. I figured that even if there were no God, it couldn't hurt to comply. Yet hard as I tried, I always seemed to fall short; there was always something more to do, or not do.

In my early twenties I found myself in a conversation with a pair of street corner preachers. Their education was limited but their faith was genuine. The person of Jesus was very appealing.

The New Testament was a defensible book; the gospel was a defensible story. As I found myself drawn to Jesus I began asking myself, how could I do this? How could I be Jewish and believe in Jesus? It seemed like such a paradox."

Monthly Updates

An Update from the Pastor...



Hi church! It's hard to believe the summer is almost gone and fall is right around the corner. With fall comes a lot of exciting things here at the church.

First, as you probably know by now, we have expanded our preschool ministry. Starting this school year, we are renaming the school Calvary Chapel Academy, which will include grades k-3 through 6th grade. Academy students will enjoy age-based learning of subjects like reading, writing, physical education, science, history, music, culinary arts, and more! Of course, Bible is a primary subject and each student receives dedicated time learning God's Word which includes classroom instruction and weekly chapel services. To get ready for the students, several

rooms on the lower level have been updated to accommodate the increase. The updates include desks, paint, decorations, and lockers for each elementary and middle school student.

In addition to the Academy, the bookstore has received a much-needed upgrade as well. With the closure of the Master's Mercantile in Pottstown, we are now the ONLY Christian bookstore in the immediate area. That means we are expecting an increase in customers looking for resources to help them in their faith. I, for one, believe it is an honor and a privilege that the Lord has allowed

us to step into that opportunity to serve others. So, let your friends know that Chronicles is open each weekday and Sunday morning. Also, we offer discounted pricing to churches needing resources.

None of the things listed above is as important as what we do on Sunday morning, however. Currently we are in a series called "Genesis to Jesus," looking at the ways Jesus is seen in the first book of the Bible. It has been a great series so far and I am excited to keep going and bring it to a conclusion in the coming month (or two).

As always, I want to thank everyone for all your prayers and help! None of this could happen without you, and for that I am grateful and humbled. Thank you for the privilege of serving you.

Property Updates

The church property is large – between 15 and 20 acres. That means it takes constant upkeep and work to ensure it remains capable of meeting the needs of the ministry. Here are some recent updates regarding the property:

Please continue to pray for a building to meet the increasing needs of the youth and school-aged ministries within the church.

This month the leadership team approved the repaving of both front entrances, as well as the front parking lot area. During repairs these entrances will be unavailable. These repairs will be completed by the end of the month.

This month we have expanded our bookstore with additional shelving and inventory graciously obtained from another local bookstore that has since gone out of business. The new shelving will expand our inventory and allow us to provide even more resources to help you grow in your faith.

The library renovation is nearing completion, with a new hallway sign officially renaming the space as "Conference room." We will still need help finishing the walls with a second coat of paint, installing trim and base board, and adding an accent wall on the north side wall adjacent to the cafe. If you would like to help with this project, please let us know by filling out a yellow card in the sanctuary seats.

Our school (Calvary Chapel Academy) is expanding this Fall, and the classrooms downstairs have been remodeled to accommodate the increased enrollment. A family in the church has generously donated funds to divide room 22/23 into two full separate classrooms, with room 22



becoming a science lab.

Our mowing team is doing a great job with maintaining the property. If you are interested in helping with mowing or other ground maintenance (like pulling weeds, trimming, leaf collection in the fall, etc.), please let us know by filling out a yellow card.

Thank you all for your continued help and support! Please pray for our volunteers who help with the property and please consider serving in this area if you are able!

MUSIC MOMENTS "Holy, Holy, Holy"



"Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God Almighty, who was, and is, and is to come." – Revelation 4:8

The hymn "Holy, Holy, Holy" by Reginald Heber is a profound expression of Christian worship that draws directly from the imagery of Revelation, the final book of the Bible. Written in 1826, the hymn echoes Revelation 4:8, where celestial beings around God's throne cry, "Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty..." This repetition of "holy" emphasizes the perfect, eternal holiness of God—a central theme in both the hymn and the scripture.

Each stanza of the hymn builds upon the vision of heavenly worship described in Revelation. Angels, saints, and all creation are pictured as joining together in eternal praise of the triune God. The hymn also acknowledges human limitation: though sinful and unworthy, believers are invited to join in heaven's worship through grace.

Musically majestic and lyrically rich, "Holy, Holy, Holy" captures the awe and reverence found in John's apocalyptic vision. It reminds us as Christians that worship is not merely a Sunday act but a reflection of the eternal praise that is already happening in heaven. By singing it, we align our voices with those of the angels, proclaiming the holiness of God across time and eternity.

The Bible verse 1 Peter 4:10 declares, "Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms" (NIV). This powerful call from Peter urges believers to serve one another, reflecting true faith in action. 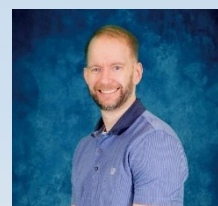
H2O Youth Group shines its light in Easton, PA on our Summer Mission Trip!

From July 20–26, our youth group had the incredible opportunity to travel to Easton, Pennsylvania, for a weeklong mission trip focused on service, compassion, and love. Partnering with a local church and community organization, our team worked at a kids' sports and arts camp, serving children from diverse backgrounds.

Each day, our students helped lead various activities from soccer and basketball drills to painting, dance, and crafts. Through these interactions, relationships were built, trust was earned, and seeds of hope and encouragement were planted. Beyond just playing games or helping with art projects, our group had meaningful conversations and showed Christ's love in tangible ways. It was a true joy to watch our youth serve God in such a meaningful way.

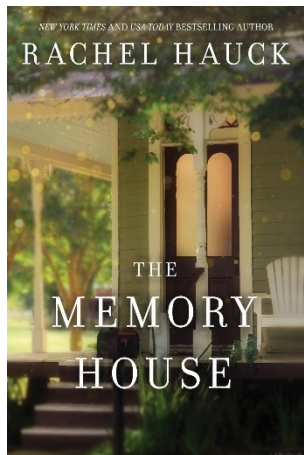

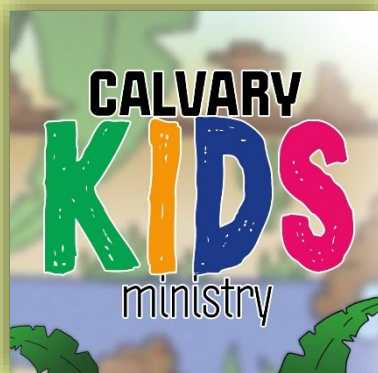
GET INVOLVED AT SHEPHERD OF THE HILLS

MINISTRY SPOTLIGHT

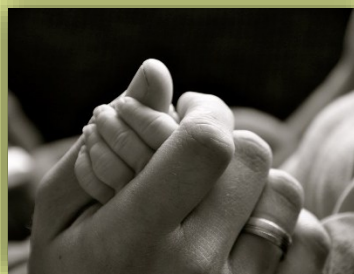
