December Missions

The Stokes family lives in the mountains of Papua Indonesia amongst a people group named the “Dem.” They are an isolated people group that have no written form of their language, never had any western influences and are completely remote. The only way in or out if by using a small missionary plane or their feet.

They have completed the translation of the Bible into the native language and have taught their first round of over 80 lessons of the Gospel. They have experienced several hundred native Dem coming to listen each day.

Currently the Stokes cannot return to the tribe at this time due to tribal fighting, but are training natives in a neighboring village.

Where they live there is no power company, no water company, no roads or corner mini mart. They live off solar panels, water from a stream and the trip to the

grocery store is a plane landing with a couple months’ worth of food.

“We are Jeremiah & Briana Stokes. We have 3 children Eden Jericho and Noelle and we are missionaries with New Tribes Mission in Indonesia.

We moved overseas July 4, 2010. We are both from Pennsylvania but opposite sides of the state. Briana is from eastern Pa and Jeremiah is from Pittsburgh. We both grew up in Christian homes but when we were in our first year of college, we were confronted with the fact that there are unreached tribal people groups that have no access to the Bible.”

Property Updates

The church property is large – between 15 and 20 acres. That means it takes constant upkeep and work to ensure it remains capable of meeting the needs of the ministry. Here are some recent updates regarding the property:

The fall is coming to an end as we move into the Christmas season. We want to thank all the volunteers who have helped keep the property maintained through the fall, from leaf cleanup, Christmas decorating, tree maintenance, and more.

As the cold season moves in, we do ask that you bear with us as our heating system works hard to keep the building comfortable. We realize that certain rooms may be slightly cooler than others and may require a sweater or jacket. Being proactive in these measures can help us keep heating costs down during the cold winter months.

As we end this year and move into the next year, the elder board has made the decision to improve building security

throughout the week and during services. Our plan is to implement these security measures as discretely as possible, as to not disrupt the normal flow of worship.

One area of security improvement that has taken effect immediately is the locking of the brown hallway doors that lead to the office hallway and classrooms. These doors will now be locked every day during business hours (as opposed to being only locked during school hours). We ask that visitors use the doorbell by the café in the lobby to gain entry to the hallway, offices, and school classrooms.

We will also be locking these doors on Sunday mornings, during all Children’s Ministry activities. If you



need access to the hallway when these doors are locked, please see the Welcome Desk volunteer(s) to gain entry. Also, please be aware that door for the lower-level entrance at the rear parking lot will now be locked all Sunday morning.

Please continue to pray for a building to meet the increasing needs of the youth and school-aged ministries within the church.

Thank you all for your continued help and support! Please pray for our volunteers who help with the property and please consider serving in this area if you are able!

MUSIC MOMENTS "A Mighty Fortress"



"God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble... The Lord Almighty is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress." – Psalm 46:1, 7

Martin Luther's hymn "A Mighty Fortress Is Our God," written around 1529, powerfully reflects the central ideas of the Protestant Reformation. The song draws directly from Psalm 46, portraying God as an unshakable refuge and defender against evil. This theme mirrors Luther's conviction that faith in God alone—*sola fide*—is the source of salvation, not the authority of the Church or human works.

The hymn's bold and confident tone captures the courage of the Reformers, who faced persecution for challenging the established Church. Its lyrics proclaim that even when earthly powers fall, God's Word endures forever, echoing Luther's belief in *sola scriptura*, the authority of Scripture above all human institutions. The song became known as the "Battle Hymn of the Reformation," inspiring believers to trust God's power amid conflict and change.

Through its triumphant melody and steadfast message, "A Mighty Fortress Is Our God" embodies the heart of the Reformation—a declaration of faith, freedom, and reliance on divine strength over worldly control.

Spiritual Care:

A Heart Tuned to Thanksgiving

"Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you." 1 Thessalonians 5:16–18

In the gentle rhythm of Thanksgiving, something sacred happens when we pause, lift our eyes, and turn our hearts toward the Lord with genuine thankfulness. It is more than a holiday tradition; it is a holy posture that reorients our entire soul.

When we choose gratitude, we remember who God truly is: infinitely good, endlessly faithful, and breathtakingly wonderful. The weight of our worries shrinks in the light of His greatness. Bills, diagnoses, broken relationships, and unspoken fears (none of them are bigger than our God). As we name His blessings and recall His past faithfulness, a quiet transformation begins inside us. Anxiety loosens its grip. Discouragement loses its

voice. Our perspective shifts from what is lacking to the One who lacks nothing.

In life's hardest seasons, thankfulness becomes our lifeline. It invites the Prince of Peace to flood the places that feel chaotic and plants joy where sorrow once ruled. Even in the valley, He is our steady song.

There will be a break for a Birthday Party and Lesson for Jesus Birthday on Dec 21st. Theme: Trust God Always

- Yellow: Joseph's Fearful Time: Genesis 39:20-40:23
Joseph ended up in jail, even though he did nothing wrong. Instead of feeling self-pity, Joseph was able to help others while he was afraid. He trusted God to see him through when he was scared.
- Purple: Joseph's Royal Position: Genesis 41:1-43
Joseph interprets a King's Dream and was rewarded greatly! In one day, Joseph went from prisoner to second in command of Egypt! No matter what changes come our way, we can trust God.
- Jesus Birthday Party: Jesus is Born: Luke 2:11, Unto us a Savior is Born!
- Blue: Joseph's Peaceful Reunion: Genesis 45:1-15
Joseph reveals himself to his brothers. Joseph was not angry or fearful when he saw his brothers, only happiness! God has a good plan for me!

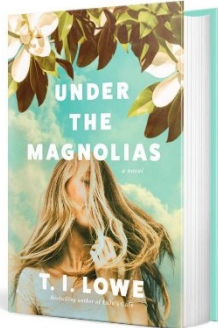
