

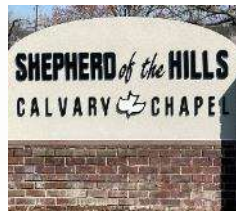
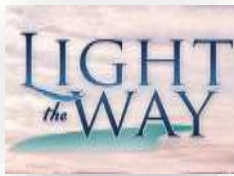

Not long after, Derrick felt God calling to devote more time into working with those struggling with depression and, as a result, he began working for Shattered Studios full time. Due to the

Hi church! It's great to see warmer weather coming and I am looking forward to summer. I want to start by thanking everyone for your prayers and support, the church would not be what it is without your help and encouragement.

I also wanted to let everyone know that we have some things coming this summer you are not going to want to miss. With warmer weather come baptisms. So, if you have not already been baptized, consider making that declaration of faith this year. We are hoping to offer a baptism service about once per month throughout the warm weather. Also, in May our pastors and other leaders will be attending the Calvary Chapel East Coast Pastor's Conference. So, please pray they would be nourished and refreshed.

We are planning some updates to the main lobby and sanctuary to help improve some of the challenges we face such as low lighting, congestion of traffic, and access to areas needed by certain ministries. There is more about that in the property update. If you would like to help with any of these things, please let the office know.

We recently added some rocking chairs to the prayer chapel. Those are intended to provide a quiet, out of the way place for people with small children. The idea is that these are in an area that is still

close to the rest of their family but also that provides for some privacy for nursing moms, and those trying to calm a small child.

We have also been blessed by your support for the school's books and I am happy to say next year's needs are met! Thank you to all who helped with that, it means a lot to know you support the kids so much.

Our teaching series right now is called "Good Grief," and focuses on the issues of life that, at first glance, seem to be difficult and discouraging, but that with the right perspective, we can see God using these things for the ultimate good. I want to encourage you to come out these Sundays, to look for the positive in negative situations, and to be reminded that God is in control!

Property Updates

The church property is large – between 15 and 20 acres. That means it takes constant upkeep and work to ensure it remains capable of meeting the needs of the ministry. Here are some recent updates regarding the property:

Thank you to everyone who came out in April for our spring-cleaning day. We had over 25 volunteers help with mulching, weeding, trimming and removing trees & bushes, and cleaning the church building.

We recently added some rocking chairs and privacy curtains to the prayer chapel. Those are intended to provide a quiet, out of the way place for people with small children.

As everyone can tell, the sanctuary can be quite dark at times, and many have commented on that over the years. We would like to brighten up the room a little but adding lighting becomes costly and unattractive to look at. So, instead, we are planning to brighten the back wall to reflect the natural light coming in from the windows and stained glass, and from the light

fixtures, along with providing a lighter and uplifting atmosphere for worship.

Our Café has been a great addition to the main lobby area, as has been the welcome desk and kiosks. The issue is, however, that they are each located in the space the other should be based on traffic flow and usage. So, because of that, and since neither has enough physical space where they are, we are planning to swap these two locations. This will give each area more usable room, make it easier on parents with



kids, and make it more convenient for people to take their snack to the parlor. It will also open up new areas of service since the café will be able to accommodate more service opportunities and the welcome desk will be able to offer more ways to help people. Look for this sometime this summer.

MUSIC MOMENTS

"Send the Light"

The beloved hymn *Send the Light* has inspired Christians for generations with its powerful message of evangelism and service. Written by Charles H. Gabriel in 1890, the hymn echoes the heart of Christ's command to His followers to take the gospel to all people. Its stirring refrain, "Send the light, the blessed gospel light," reminds us that the good news of Jesus Christ is meant to shine into every corner of the world.

The hymn reflects the Great Commission found in Matthew 28:19–20, where Jesus instructed His disciples to "go and make disciples of all nations." Christ did not intend for His disciples to keep the message of salvation to themselves. Instead, they were to carry the light of the gospel to those living in spiritual darkness. *Send the Light* serves as a call for us believers to continue that mission today.

While the hymn encourages worldwide evangelism, it also reminds us that we can be lights in our everyday lives. Jesus says in Matthew 5:14, "You are the light of the world." We shine that light through acts of kindness, words of encouragement, faithful witness, and lives that reflect Christ's love and truth. Whether at home, at work, in school, or in the community, we all have opportunities to point others to Jesus.

As we sing *Send the Light*, we are reminded of both our privilege and responsibility. The hymn calls God's people to faithfully share the gospel and to let the light of Christ shine brightly through our daily lives.

Spiritual Care:

When Salvation Is Uncertain: Resting in God's Mercy and Wisdom

"The secret things belong to the Lord our God, but the things that are revealed belong to us and to our children forever, that we may do all the words of this law."

Deuteronomy 29:29

Grieving the loss of a loved one is heavy, but an even deeper ache comes when we're unsure of their salvation. Scripture does not ask us to ignore that pain; instead, it invites us to bring it into the presence of a God who is both just and overflowing with mercy. In **Deuteronomy 29:29**, we're reminded that "the secret things belong to the Lord," which means their eternity is ultimately in His hands, not ours. We can rest in the truth that God knows every heart fully, sees every moment clearly, and judges with perfect righteousness and compassion.

For the believer, grief becomes a place where trust is refined. We entrust our loved one to the God who loved them more than we ever

could. We also allow the Holy Spirit to shepherd our own hearts, reminding us that sorrow is not a sign of weak faith but of deep love.

Let your grief move you toward prayer, not despair. Let it stir urgency for the gospel in the lives of those still here. And let it anchor you in the hope that Christ is making all things new. Even in unanswered questions, God offers Himself—His presence, His comfort, and His peace that surpasses understanding.

In addition, our summer Vacation Bible School, our Wednesday night H2O Kids, and other children's events are all part of Calvary Kids.

Sunday Morning Kids Ministries:

9:30 AM Service: Kids are encouraged to attend our Sunday School for all ages for the whole 9:30-10:30 AM hour. We also have childcare for infants and toddlers.

11:00 AM Service: Kids are dismissed following the songs of worship to Children's Church and Care Room

*****Children are encouraged to bring in their water bottles and Bibles*****

Preschool - Kindergarten Sunday School: Fruit of the Spirit (Meets upstairs in Pre-K Classroom)

*Parents, please see the take home paper your children bring home after class. These papers will show you what they have learned in Sunday School.

Your children will finish the series, "Protected by the Armor of God". Children will see each piece of armor, in Ephesian 6, using different stories throughout the Bible. The kids will start a new series "David and the Giant", Ephesians 13:5b. The children will learn about the early life of David. God was with David, every step of the way, and God is with us too!

- **Helmet of Salvation:** Put on the helmet of Salvation: Know that salvation comes through Jesus only. Jesus came to save us from our sins. The story of the Crucifixion, Luke 23:31-43
- **Prayer:** Prayer is talking to God: We can talk to God at any time about anything! He listens and He answers us, amazing! God loves us and wants the best for us. Peter's Escape from prison, Acts 12:1-16
- **The Full Armor of God:** God gifts Christian's A Full Armor. The soldier's attire of truth, righteousness, peace, faith salvation, the Bible and prayer help us stay strong against evil. Ephesians 6:13a
- **The Secret King:** Samuel Anoints David. David didn't know the big things God had planned for his life, but he knew he could trust God. You can trust God too, because He loves you and wants the best for you. 1 Samuel 16:1-13

1st-4th Grades (Downstairs Classrooms) *Parents, please see the "Make it Stick" papers we send home with the children, for a better description and how to reinforce what they have learned throughout the week. We also send home a memory verse for them to learn. We give them an incentive to remember scripture.

The children will be starting a new lesson series, "High Score" How to Win at Life". A video game themed study that follows the life of Elijah, a prophet of God. Elijah knew the secret of how to win at life. Live a life devoted to and focused on God.

Memory Verse: Trust in the Lord with all your heart. Do not depend on your own understanding. In all your ways obey Him. Then He will make your paths smooth and straight. Proverbs 3:5-6

- **Player One: Famine in Israel,** 1Kings 17:1-6
Kids will learn" I will go where God leads even when it is hard.
- **Easter Eggs and Regenerate: Elijah and the Widow/The Widow's Son,** 1 Kings 17:7-24
Kids will learn I can trust God to know and provide what I need and that God is mighty and powerful to save.
- **Glitch: Elijah on Mount Carmel,** 1 Kings 18:17-39
Kids will learn that there is only One true God.
- **Energy Restored and Noob: God speaks to Elijah/Elijah and Elisha,** 1Kings 19:1-18
Kids will learn they can always call out to God and it is important to have Godly friends.

5-6th Grades (Downstairs Classroom) The kids will be finishing "Freedom in Christ, A Study of Galatians". They will then study the Book of Acts and the Early Church.

Kids are to be picked up in the back parking lot, since the children will be getting cleaned up from water games. The children will be learning through Bible stories, object lessons, games, videos and crafts, all reinforcing God's Word. They will also have worship and prayer.

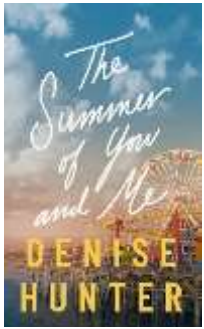
